## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

And

### 1. Parties :

This Memorandum of Understanding ( hereinafter referred to as "MOU" )  
is made and entered into by and between the

a) Sri ABR Government Degree College, Repalle, Bapatla District

And

b) K.S.N. Government College for Women, Ananthapuramu

2. Purpose :

- The purpose of this MOU is intended to enable NAAC Accreditation Aspirant Institution to get accredited with in next few months and thus upgrade their academic performance and also to promote and enrich teaching and learning process of the faculty of Party 1 and for the quality instructions for the Party 2.

3. Term of MOU :

- This MOU is effective upon the day and date signed and will be executed by the parties from July, 2022 and shall remain in full force and effect for not longer than 5 years. This MOU may be terminated, without cause, by either party upon two months written notice, which notice shall be delivered by hand or by certified mail to the address listed above.

4. Responsibilities of Parties :

Responsibilities of the Mentoring Institution :

- Guiding the mentee institution in the preparation of the Self Study Report, development of infrasture and effective use of ICT facilities in teaching-learning process by conducting workshops and sharing the knowledge.
- Mentoring shall be imparted through the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)
- The mentoring institute shall nominate an Accreditation Ambassador who will be in charge of this program.
- Training of faculty and staff of the mentee institution for proper processes, documentation and presentation.
- Sharing of knowledge, information and intellectual resources.Guidance and encouragement to adopt best practices.

Responsibilities of the Mentee Institution :

- The Participating Institution is required to nominate a coordinator for an IQAC and also an IQAC committee consisting members from different departments.
- The institution is expected to participate in various activities like Mentor-Mentee meeting, developing strategies and defining goals and deliver lectures when necessary.

Responsibilities of Both Parties :

- The faculty and students of Party 1 will teach/train the faculty and students of Party 2, so as to enrich the teaching experience of faculty and learning experience of students of the Party 2 as per the schedule resolved in the meeting held on 29-06-2022 in the Chamber of the Principal, Sri ABR Government Degree College, Repalle.
- The Party 2 may request some of the faculty or students of Party 1 to address the faculty or students of Party 1.
- Mere participation of faculty and students of Party 1 in teaching the faulty and students of Party 2 according to this MOU doest not carry any right or any legal entitlement to demand for placement with Party 2.
- The Colleges shall entrust a faculty member in their respective colleges to liaison between the parties.

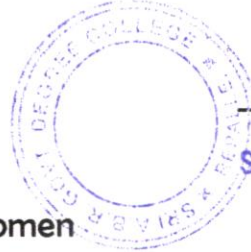
